

**Eagle Island State Historic Site**  
COVID-19 Visitor Guidance  
May 6, 2020

In addition to following all Maine State Park rules, please help us keep each other safe by observing the following special guidelines for Eagle Island State Historic. **Guidance for visitors of Eagle Island State Historic Site**

1. Anyone arriving to Maine from out of state must immediately self-quarantine for a 14-day period prior to visiting any Maine State Park or Historic Site including Eagle Island (EO 34 FY 19/20).
2. All individuals shall maintain a minimum distance of at least six feet from other persons unless they reside in the same household (EO 28 FY 19/20).
3. Groups larger than ten people are prohibited from visiting Maine State Parks and Historic Sites (EO 14 FY 19/20).
4. All persons are encouraged to carry and use alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol:
  - a. Before touching commonly touched surfaces
  - b. Before and after handling food, eating or touching your face
  - c. After using a restroom facility
  - d. After coughing, sneezing or blowing your nose
5. Anyone who is not feeling well should stay home.

**Facility Restrictions and Operational Curtailments**

*Launch Service*

1. Eagle Island launch service is suspended until further notice.
2. The use of a personal dinghy is highly encouraged. Personal dinghies may be tied up to the north side of the float and kayaks may be kept on the beach above the high-water mark.

*Friends of Peary's Eagle Island – Docent Program*

1. The Eagle Island Docent Program is suspended until further notice due to COVID-19

*Facility Restrictions*

Eagle Island State Historic Site is tentatively scheduled to open on: June 15, 2020 (subject to change)

1. Only one family/household group is allowed on the float, ramp and pier at a time.
2. The Peary museum and library are closed until further notice.
3. The Welcome Center is closed until further notice.
4. Eagle Island State Historic Site's trails are scheduled to open around July 15, 2020
5. Congregating shall be avoided at all times.

**Park Entrance Fees**

1. Maine State Park and Historic Site day-use fees apply year-round at all facilities.
2. Please place park entrance fees into the fee collection station at the end of the pier.
